Cathedral Mass Celebrating Marriage



Mass for Migrants Monday 5 May

In this special Jubilee Year, you are warmly invited to join the three 'London' Dioceses of Brentwood, Southwark and Westminster for the annual Mass for Migrants on **Bank Holiday Monday**, **5 May 2025 at Westminster Cathedral**, **starting at 2.00pm with a procession of banners**.

This year the Mass is hosted by the Diocese of Westminster at Westminster Cathedral.

The Mass is prepared by the Justice & Peace Commissions, Caritas and Ethnic Chaplaincies of the three Dioceses and celebrates the contributions made to faith, life and work in the UK by all those who come from other countries to make a home here. Music will be provided by musicians from the Lourdes Mass and a variety of Ethnic Chaplaincy choirs. We will also be joined by community organisers from London Citizens

Everyone is invited to wear national dress. Those taking part in the procession are invited to arrive from 1.30pm where light refreshments will be provided and a locked space in which to leave possessions during the Mass. Do come along and bring the family, whether you are from a migrant background or not! It is always a colourful and a lively occasion.

'On Pilgrimage' from Easter to Pentecost in our Parish and Diocese

NEXT Saturday 10 May, join in a local **Jubilee Walking Pilgrimage** with people from neighbouring parishes, starting here or at Holy Ghost Parish Church. **PARTICIPANTS LEAVE HERE AT 9.15AM**. *En route* there will be Mass at Holy Ghost at 10am, Adoration at Sacred Heart, Lunch at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, and Evening Prayer and Refreshments here in the mid-afternoon.

First Holy Communions will be celebrated NEXT Sunday 11 May at 11am Mass.

Our Diocese is offering a six-session course 'Pilgrimage to Pentecost' course, to help deepen our understanding of the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

Sessions comprise pre-recorded talks, a faith testimony, and music, and are accessible via YouTube, plus an opportunity to share with others online or in person. The course booklet is now available. The booklet has meditations for every day until the week after Pentecost. You can follow this course on your own at home, join a group

in the Parish, or join an Online Group.
