They would love to see as many young people there as possible — it's a great opportunity to grow in faith and community. If you have any questions, feel free to get in touch.


'Safeguarding Sunday' 2025 - 18 May.

Each of us — clergy, volunteers, parents, parishioners — is called to remain vigilant, informed, and committed to the well-being of every member of our community". June 7th will be a day of fun and faith for all the family: talks, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the Rosary, Confessions, Prayer for Healing, exhibitions and fun activities for children, as well as the joy of just being outside relaxing in this beautiful historic place. Bring your own picnics, but food, including a barbecue, a tea room and ice creams will be available on site (though probably with long queues). The day will end with a concelebrated Mass led by Archbishop John, who will pray a special blessing on all those present and on the whole diocese.

For our Prayer

Pray for Pope Leo XIV and for an outpouring of all the graces of the Holy Spirit he will need for his ministry for the whole Church.

Pray for Peace. At this time, when Europe has been recalling the huge sacrifice of the second World War, that ended eighty years ago, pray that today's leaders may not forgot the lessons, and all those whose experience led them to pray 'never again'.

For a just end to the Ukraine war. For peace in the Middle East, and an end to Israel's war in Gaza, and campaign of destruction to intimidate and annex the Palestinian people of the occupied West Bank. For peace in Sudan, and in the DRC.

So many innocents go on suffering. Pray fervently for lasting peace with justice for all, for an end to the starvation, killing, wounding, and trauma of innocents, and the utterly unnecessary destruction of people's homes and livelihoods.

Pray for Peace in so many other troubled places across our world including: Afghanistan, Armenia and Azerbaijan, Cameroun, Chad, China, Colombia, Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Haiti, Hong Kong, Mali, Myanmar, Nigeria, Russia, Sudan, Thailand, Yemen.... and all the other places where the innocent are caught up in the violent power struggles of others.

And for the many Christians who in so many parts of the world continue to face persecution for their faith in Jesus Christ, the incarnate Son of God.

For the youngsters who receive their first Holy Communion at this time; and for Max de Lisle and all our teenagers who were recently confirmed.

For all our young parishioners who are taking public exams over these weeks that their study will be blessed.

Make sure to pray for the defeat of the Assisted Dying Bill which returns to the House of Commons on 16 May. It is shocking to read of the official Government assessment, which quantifies the money 'saved' on end of life care, but puts no value on the lives killed.
